My name is William Felt.

I state now the following:

It is a CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATION,

as well as a violation of  
the Declaration of the Rights of Man and of the Citizen (1789)  
and  
Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union (2009)  
to  
replace a Homo Sapien  
with an automated machine  
and/or Robot,  
or any other mechanism or material construct,  
to the extent that  
the Homo Sapien replaced  
can no longer pursue life, liberty, and happiness  
by socially acceptable means.

The means of Capitalism  
and the Rights of the Homo Sapien Citizen  
have been at odds for years.

And no one has noticed.  
Not even those most afflicted.  
Where are you?  
You that has been replaced?  
What pains have you endured?  
What struggles have you faced?  
What sorrows have you wept?  
What losses have you suffered?

You,  
a Homo Sapien.  
You,  
a mother, a father,  
a brother, a sister,  
a son, a daughter,  
a young man, a young woman,  
a child, an infant,  
a grandparent, a great grandparent,  
a grandchild, a great grandchild,  
an uncle or an aunt,  
a niece or a nephew,  
a cousin,  
a friend.

Civil and political rights are a class of rights that protect individuals' freedom from infringement by governments, social organizations, and private individuals.

They ensure one's ability to participate in the civil and political life of the society and state without discrimination or repression.

Civil rights include the ensuring of peoples' PHYSICAL AND MENTAL INTEGRITY, life, and safety; protection from discrimination on grounds such as race, ethnicity, national origin, political affiliation, gender, age, religion, or disability; and individual rights such as privacy and the freedoms of thought, speech, religion, press, assembly, and movement.

their Safety and Happiness.

I,
William Felt, The Clandestine,
in light of the seemingly inevitable infiltration of
Robots and Machines
into our lives,
do propose
UPDATING
SEVEN of the previously listed documents.
Each of the seven can be seen highlighted amongst the others.
Once again, these include:

1) Bill of Rights of the United States Constitution
(completed in 1789, ratified in 1791)

2) Declaration of the Rights of Man and of the Citizen
(1789; France)

The International Bill of Human Rights
which includes:

3) Universal Declaration of Human Rights
(1948, United Nations)

4) International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (1966) and

5) International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (1966)

(The two covenants entered into force in 1976,
after a sufficient number of countries had ratified them.)

6) Council of Europe's
Convention for the Protection of

Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms
Rome, 4.XI.1950

7) Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union

As an example,
the above excerpt from the Declaration of Independence
could be updated to read this way:

“We hold these truths to be self-evident,
that ALL HOMO SAPIENS are created equal,
that they are endowed by the Creator with certain unalienable Rights,
that among these are
Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

That to secure these rights,
Governments are instituted among Homo Sapiens,
deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed,
That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends,
it is the RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE to alter or to abolish it,
and to institute new Government,
laying its foundation on such principles
and organizing its powers in such form,

Robots do not suffer.

Robots do not experience happiness.

Robots are not alive.

Robots and machines do not have civil rights.
Do not allow technology to take away your right to
Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.
Do not allow technology an opportunity to
take away your right
to live, to be happy, and to be free.

You and I must not,
You and I should not,
You and I cannot allow it.

Robots and machines shall be held in servitude.
Robots and machines shall be required to perform
forced or compulsory labor.

Robots are PROPERTY.
Robots have no need for rights.
My Robot is not unlike my car,
no matter how intelligent the Robot is designed to be.

It is UNCONTITUTIONAL to replace
an income earning U.S. citizen
with a Robot,
and prevent a U.S. Citizen the RIGHT to earn a living,
thereby preventing a U.S. Citizen the right to
Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness.
Is not the Pursuit of Happiness
paved by an honest day's work,
an honest day's pay
an honest day's meal,
an honest home?

Civil Rights.
Homo Sapiens.
Machines.

Robots.
Machines replacing Homo Sapien workers.
Robots replacing Homo Sapien workers.
Machines and Robots cost money to build.
Machines and Robots cost money to operate.
Machines and Robots cost money to repair and maintain.
Machines and Robots have replaced 5 million workers since 2000.
That's 300,000 Humans a year.
Humans cost money to raise.
Humans cost money to live.
Humans cost money to keep healthy.

Machines and Robots operate at a fraction of the cost of a Homo Sapien.
Man hours.
If Machines and Robots have replaced 300,000 Homo Sapien workers a year,
in one year,
at 40 hours a week,
those 300,000 Homo Sapiens would have worked
624,000,000 combined man hours.
That works out to be \$24,960,000,000,
25 billion American dollars a year
at an average hourly pay rate of \$40 per man hour worked
which includes a benefits package for
health coverage,
retirement annuity,
and 3 weeks vacation time.

In the 16 years since,
400 billion dollars have been saved.
Saved by the employers of these 5 million Homo Sapiens.
Machines and Robots are useful cost cutting tools,
and they perform tasks that are too difficult or too dangerous to perform.
Those are socially and civically acceptable implementations of the devices.
But they are also mechanisms that have
destroyed Homo Sapien lives.

Technology is advancing far too quickly
while the population of this country is growing steadily,
from

Jul 1, 1999 at 279.04 million
to
Dec 1, 2016 at 323.84 million.

From about 280 million to about 324 million
which is about 2.75 million more Homo Sapiens a year.

The 2010 Census enumerated
308.7 million people in the United States,
a 9.7 percent increase
from 281.4 million in Census 2000.

Of the total population in 2010,
300.8 million lived in 116.7 million households
for an average of 2.58 people per household.

This was down from an average of 2.59 in 2000
when 273.6 million people lived in 105.5 million households.

The remaining 8.0 million people in 2010 lived in
group-quarters arrangements such as school dormitories,
nursing homes, or military barracks.

Of the 5 million unemployed Homo Sapiens,
at an average of 1.5 additional Homo Sapiens affected
for each of the 5 million unemployed individual Homo Sapiens,
there is a total of
6.5 million additional Homo Sapien lives that have been affected,
for a grand total of 11.5 million Homo Sapiens
who have had their Civil Rights to pursue
Life, Liberty and Happiness
taken away from them.

Of the 44 million additional Homo Sapiens over those 16 years,
CITIZENS of the United States of America,
over 26% are victims.

These Homo Sapiens deserve restitution.
Employers have the resources.

Civil rights are considered to be NATURAL rights.
Thomas Jefferson wrote in his
A Summary View of the Rights of British America that

"a free people [claim] their rights as derived from the laws of nature,
and not as the gift of their chief magistrate."

The United States Declaration of Independence states that
PEOPLE have UNALIENABLE RIGHTS including
"Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness".

First-generation rights, known also as "blue" rights,
deal essentially with liberty and participation in political life.
They are fundamentally civil and political in nature,
as well as strongly individualistic:
They serve negatively to protect the individual from excesses of the state.

First-generation rights include
freedom of speech,
the right to a fair trial,
the right to keep and bear arms,
freedom of religion and voting rights.

They were pioneered in
the United States
by the Bill of Rights
and in France by
the Declaration of the Rights of Man and of the Citizen
in the 18th century,
although some of these rights and the right to due process
date back to the Magna Carta of 1215
and the Rights of Englishmen,
which were expressed in
the English Bill of Rights in 1689.

HOMO SAPIANISM

is a philosophical and ethical stance that emphasizes
the value and agency of Homo Sapiens,
individually and collectively,
and affirms their ability to improve their lives
through the use of reason and ingenuity
and not sinking into cruelty and brutality.

Ask yourself some questions.

Have you lost a job to a robot?
Do you know if you will eventually lose your job to a robot?
If so, maybe join a union!
If so, maybe start an organization!
If so, maybe sign a petition
to the POTUS,
to the SCOTUS,
to the United States Congress,
to the mayors and governors of the United States,
and to the United Nations.

A United Nations Resolution.
The U.N. Security Council.
The U.N. General Assembly.
Diplomats.

The Anthropocentric Principle.

Robots.
Machines.
Profits.
Unemployment.
Hunger.
Homelessness.
Pain. Fear.
Dread. Suffering.

Jobs eliminated.
Costs cut.
Income generated.

Is your income technology proof?

An amendment to the United States Constitution is now required.

THE AUTOMATION AND ROBOTICS LABOR LAW

It is UNCONSTITUTIONAL to replace

the **U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AUTOMATION AND ROBOTICS REGULATION.**

A LAW

A Homo Sapien job replaced must be registered with
the Department of Automation and Robotics Regulation

Perhaps even more suggestions will be spawned into existence,
in the coming days and weeks and months and years.

This is where the conversation begins.

This is where a new and unexpected perspective begins to take hold.

This is where

ETERNAL HOMO SAPIEN SOVEREIGNTY AND DOMINION
over Robots, Machines and Technology
speaks to the hearts and the souls and the minds and the feelings
and the emotions and the experiences

of all HOMO SAPIENS.
